

PAR-3 GOLF & FOOT GOLF RULES

- Foot golfers use the holes marked with orange flags.
- Kick off your ball from a position up to six feet behind the tee markers.
- Par-3 golfers use the holes marked with red, white or blue flags.
- Play the ball from where it lies.
Exception: You may mark the spot and lift the ball when it obstructs another player's kick or ball in any way.
- The player farthest from the hole is the first to kick or play the ball.
- Do not tee off before preceding players have left the green.
- Keep pace; allow faster players through.
- The order of play is established based on the score of the previous hole. The player with the best score will go first on the next hole followed by the second.
- Do not take practice swings on the greens.
- A ball landing on the wrong green must be lifted and placed off the green, but no closer to the hole.
- The flag may be removed from the cup while putting, but must be replaced before leaving the green.
- No walkers; only paying customers.
- Report any course problems to the attendant.
